ACCESS THE USB USING WINDOWS

- (1) Insert the device into a USB port on your computer and enter your password.
- 2 Once you have typed in your password, click the 'Login' button to continue.
 - If the correct password is entered, the device will unlock, and you can access your data room.
 - × If an incorrect password is entered, an error message will appear just below the 'Hint' field, indicating a log-in failure.

- 1 Insert the DTL+ G3 into a USB port.
- 2 Double-click the DTL+ G3 DVD icon.
